For the People Speeding in Sweetwater

It always happens to someone else. Don't worry, it can't possibly happen to you.

Yesterday, July 17th in Poinciana around 1:30 pm in a beautiful community just like Sweetwater with a 20 MPH speed limit, a call came in for a single vehicle crash. A golf cart verses a light pole. A 70 year old women laying face down in the street unconscious and shallow breathing. She was obviously ejected from the golf cart on impact. EMS and Fire Rescue transported to the hospital while PCSO went to locate her husband.

We don't know how fast she may have been going. We don't know if she took her eyes off the roadway at the bend. We don't know if she bent down to pick up something she dropped. We don't know if she had a medical condition.

What we DO know is that at approximately 4:55 pm, she was pronounced dead at the hospital.

Her husband devastated, her family looking for answers they will probably never get. But don't worry, IT CAN'T POSSIBLY HAPPEN TO YOU.

What's Happening in Sweetwater

Jeanette DeLisi-Upcoming Social Club events-Trivia Sunday August 13 at 4:00 in the ballroom. Tickets \$7.00 includes pizza. Due to the hail storm the entire clubhouse roof needs to be replaced. We are in the process of getting bids. The ballroom floor looks great, thanks to Sue Sweeney.

Anita Love-Why is the pool so hot? The solar panels are made to heat the pool in the winter. In the summer, at night it will turn on automatically when the water on the roof is cooler than the pool. This thermostat is the part that has failed. The system has been shut down. The pool heaters have been shut down since summer began. The heat in the pool is coming from the outside temperatures, not the solar panels. This is the first time this part has gone bad. The "Pentair Solar Touch Power Circuit Board Assembly" was ordered on 6/27 and is on backorder. When this is resolved we can appreciate solving the problem and making the pool operate efficiently for your enjoyment.

Butterfly group will be changing the days they meet to the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of every month. We also will be changing our name soon to add the Gardening. A new item will be coming soon to raffle off and as always, thank you for your continued support. Pro Shop-Summer hours are in effect 7-9 AM and closed on Thursday and Sunday.

Steve Gade-Greens will be aerated on July 24th, then plugging some bare areas on some greens. The Nematode count is down with a new product. New numbers have been installed on the fencing in the storage area. Canals have been sprayed to eliminate growth of duck weed as well as the canal by the lake. The first 2 docks are completed. Waiting for electrician to finish the pump replacement on #3. The magnet is working and picking up screws and nails from the roofers. Remember do not give out your 4 digit code to anyone. If it has been given out to a repair service and your code doesn't work, it's because an unauthorized person used it and it was removed. If this happens call the office for a new code. Have the repair person call your house number and that will ring on your phone you have registered. Then press and hold the number 9 and the gate will open.

Application for use of the Clubhouse

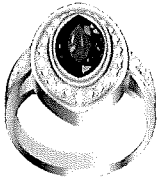
Starting in September 2023, we will be switching to yearly color coded Reservation sheets for the use of the Clubhouse.
