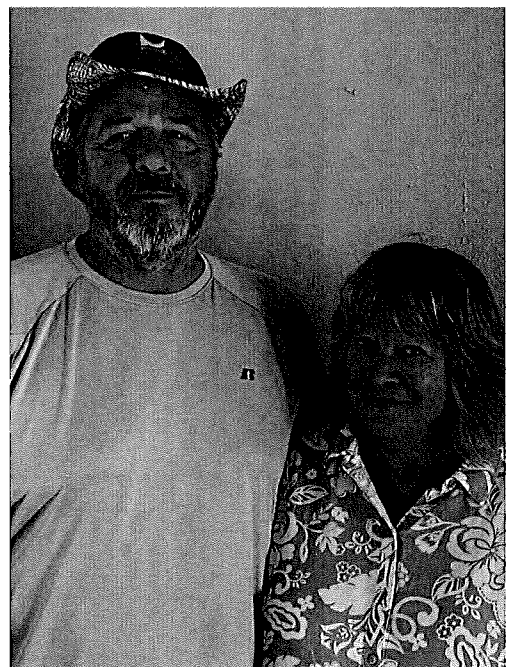

## Application for use of the Clubhouse

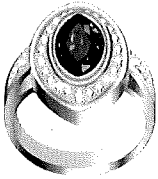
Starting in September 2023, we will be switching to yearly color coded Reservation sheets for the use of the Clubhouse.
