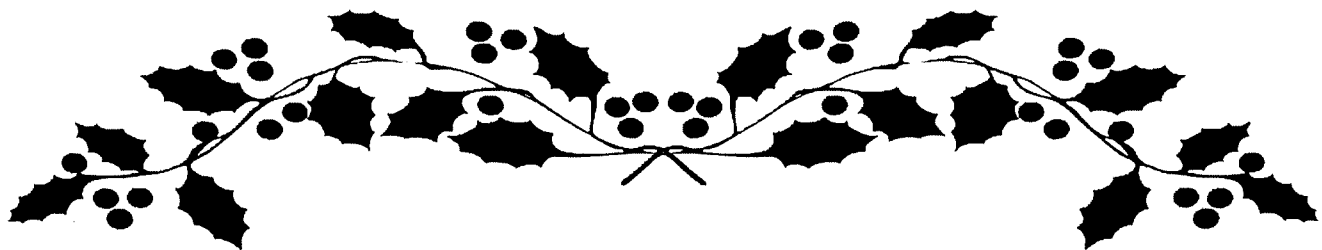
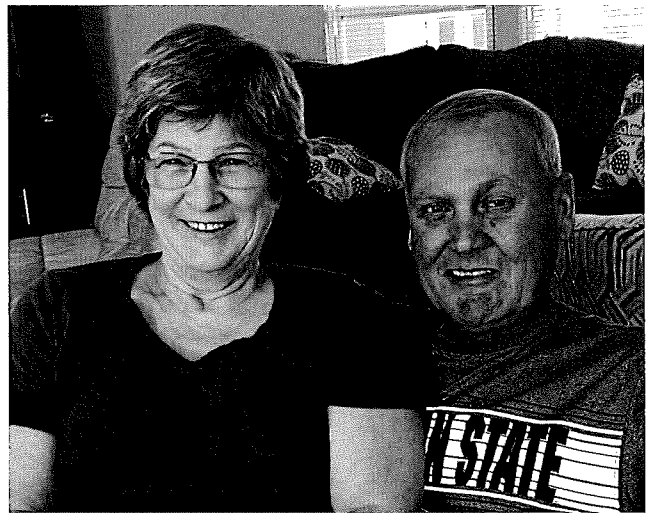

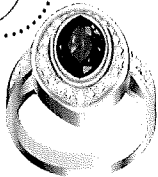

The meeting was adjourned at 9:32AM by President Mary Slevinski.

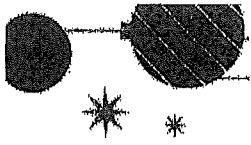
